William F. Lehman American History Scholarship Bourbon County High School Graduate

Scholarship Overview:

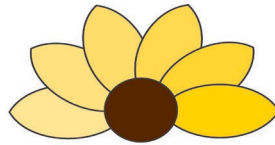
The William F. Lehman American History Scholarship shall be awarded to a recent or past Bourbon County High School graduate.

The student will be planning to attend or is attending an accredited institution of higher learning as a full-time student enrolled in or planning to enroll in a course or coursework studying any aspect of American history.

Scholarship funds will be distributed from the William F. Lehman American History Scholarship Fund through the Community Foundation of Southeast Kansas.

Scholarship Requirements:

1. Applicants must be a graduate of a high school located in Bourbon County, Kansas.
2. Applicants must have earned at least a cumulative 3.0 GPA in high school.
3. Recipients will be required to carry a minimum of 12 hours each semester in an academic program, enrolled in at least 3 credit hours of American studies.
4. The student must maintain a 2.5 cumulative grade point average on a 4-point scale. In the event the student's GPA falls below 2.5 for one semester, the student will not receive the scholarship the following semester, except under extenuating circumstances which will be reviewed and decided upon by the advisory Committee.
5. One-half of the scholarship will be awarded prior to the start of the fall semester and one-half at the start of the spring semester.
6. Enrollment verification in required coursework for fall and spring semesters must be provided prior to payment.
7. In the event the student withdraws from his/her academic program after enrolling and receiving the scholarship money, he/she must return the money awarded for the semester in which the student withdraws.
8. Scholarship funds will be distributed through the Community Foundation of Southeast Kansas. The amount of each scholarship shall be determined by the Advisory Committee of the Scholarship fund. This is not a continuing scholarship. Previous recipients may re-apply.
9. All applications **MUST** be typed.
10. Any relative of the donor or of the Advisory selection committee is not eligible to apply due to IRS regulations.
11. Scholarship recipients are eligible to re-apply for the Lehman Scholarship.
